SEED POTATO 2012

ALL BLUE **SOLD OUT** 20

Dark Blue skin with almost purple flesh. Plants have beautiful blue flower that produce lots of oblong tubers. Makes beautiful mashed potatoes and great in potato salad for a little more color.

ALL RED **SOLD OUT** 25

Bright red skin with a reddish starburst flesh. Plants are medium in size and produce good sized tubers, but not too large. Great to mix with other varieties of potatoes when cooking

CAL WHITE **SOLD OUT**

A white potato that is good in place of Kennebec. It produces very large smooth oblong tubers with a thin skin. The plant is large in size and yields well

DARK RED NORLAND 75
SOLD OUT

An early red what has almost burgundy colored skin with white flesh and shallow eyes. Great fried and in potato salad.

RED PONTIAC 100
SOLD OUT

An old time favorite of gardeners. It grows well in about any climate. Plants are big and can produce huge white flesh, deep-eyed potatoes. Stores well.

RUSSET BURBANK 100

Famous Idaho potato, brown net skin, great cooked any way a person likes: mashed, fried, boiled, or baked. It produces a large leafy plant with good yields.

YUKON GEM 100

This is a newer variety. It is a lot like a yukon gold. It is yellow fleshed and yields very well, but it's days to maturity is a couple weeks longer.

YUKON GOLD 80

Yellow fleshed, smooth, thin skinned with shallow pink eyes. A great potato. Excellent baked or mashed. After they are cooked they appear to already have butter on them. The plant grows large and stands very tall. It sets on early and can produce huge tubers. It stores very well.

FINGERLING POTATO 2012

- BANANA FINGERLING **SOLD OUT** 95-135 This heirloom has an exceptional, mouthwatering flavor. Large yields. Perfect baked, boiled, or in salads.
- FRENCH FINGERLING **SOLD OUT** 0-110 Rose-colored skin covers creamy yellow flesh. Very versatile- good for any type of preparation. Peeling is not necessary. Rumored to have been smuggled into America in a horse's feedbag in the 1800s.
- ROSE FINN APPLE FINGERLING **SOLD OUT** 105-135 Heirloom. Blush colored skin with bright yellow flesh. Moderately dry flesh has a superb flavor that is popular in gourmet markets. Medium sized tubers are long and narrow. Good storage. High field resistance to scab.

SWEET POTATO 2012

FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE!

- CENTENNIAL 100 This could be the most widely recognized sweet potato. Carrot color inside with copper to orange outside skin. "Baby Bakers" in about 90 days. This variety has been used in many bakeoff contests.
- NANCY HALL 110 The "Yellow Yam" of the 30's and 40's. Older gardener's favorite. Light skin, yellow flesh. Juicy, waxy, and sweet when baked. If taste is more important than beauty, try Nancy Halls.
- O'HENRY 90-100 A white-skinned, cream-fleshed sweet potato that cooks up drier than other sweet potato varieties. Has a different look from the other darker-skinned sweet potatoes.
- MURASAKI 120 Recently released from LSU, this variety has purple skin and white flesh. Japanese sweet potato. Has a nutty flavor along with a high vitamin content. Resistant to many sweet potato diseases.
