LAVENDER/LAVANDIN

Lavenders are loved for their lovely fragrance & beautiful flowers. Lavandins are hybrids between English Lavenders & Spike Lavenders. Lavandins are taller growing & more tolerant of warm, humid summers. Lavender and Lavandin are wonderful for fresh or dried cut flowers. All Lavenders & Lavandins are drought tolerant after the 1st year and deer resistant. They all need sun and well drained soil.

Betty's Blue	18-20 in.	Dark purple	Compact. Silver-grey foliage.
Buena Vista	18-24 in.	Purple	Very fragrant. Blooms twice. Good for all.
Hidcote	18-24 in.	Dark Purple	Slow grower. Very hardy in well-drained soils.
Hidcote Superior	15 in.	Deep-blue violet	Fragrant. Perfect for hedges
Hidcote pink	18-20 in.	Pink	Greener foliage. Very hardy in well-drained soils
Jean Davis	20-24 in.	Light Pink	Semi-dwarf. 8-10" flowers. Nice foliage.
Melissa	18-20 in.	Pink & White	Compact, greener foliage. Unique flower color.
Munstead Strain	1-2 ft.	Lavender	Very hardy in well-drained soils.
Sawyer's	18-20 in.	Dark purple	Wooly, silver-grey foliage. Nice flowers.
Twickle Purple	18-20 in.	Lavender-Blue	Semi-dwarf. Fan-like blooming habit. Fragrant.

Dilly Dilly	2 ft.	Purple-Blue	Very fragrant.
Fred Boutin	18-20 in.	Violet	Compact. Fragrant, late bloomer.
Grosso (Fat Spike)	20-24 in.	Violet	Compact, dark flower heads.
Hidcote Giant	20-24 in.	Aster-violet	Long spikes, compact flower heads.
Provence	2-3 ft.	Mauve	Very fragrant! Culinary. Blooms on long spikes.
Silver Edge	10-12 in.	Lavender-blue	Gray foliage with white edge.
Super	18-20 in.	Violet-blue	Very fragrant. Blooms mid-summer on long spikes
White	2-3 ft.	Pure White	Very fragrant flowers bloom on long stems.

Gray French	3 ft.	Light mauve	Tender perennial. Fragrant. Medicinal uses.
Green French	3 ft.	Light mauve	Tender perennial. Very fragrant flowers.
